BICYCLE STRUCK, YOUTH INJURED

Accident Near Where
Brother Killed.

His bicycle bowled over by a nine-ton truck trailer, a 16-year-old East High school student was severely injured about 3:40 p. m. Thursday in front of 2719 E. Fourteenth st.

The youth, Merle E. See, of 4002 E. Douglas ave., was taken to Broadlawns General hospital suffering from shock, a lacerated head and a wrenched left arm. He was returning home from school at the time of the accident.

Leslie Spurlock, 22, of Charles City, Ia., driver of the truck, was arrested three miles north of the city on Highway 65 by a state highway patrolman.

Spurlock, going north, said he did not know his trailer had hit the bicycle. He was released after police had obtained his statement.

Young See was injured less than a mile from where his brother, Robert, 23, was killed a year ago last July when an automobile struck a motorcycle he was riding.

Robert was killed at E. Twenty-second st. and Euclid ave.

Merle's father, Frank See, is a roofer.
